Entrants will compete in **Weight Categories**

Gold, Silver, Bronze and Fourth place Bronze Medals

The Shodan Trophy is awarded to the Winning Club to keep and try to retain at next year's competition.

2007 Winners was Blacklands Judo Club on 69 points with Chippenham Second on 66 points.

Additional medals are to be awarded for the **Best Throw – Male & Female** and **Special Recognition awards**

Calne, Chippenham and *Town Hall* Judo clubs are the main clubs competing. Entrants from local schools will combine to make a schools team. The more competitors from the same club, the better your chance of success, so show your support for your Club.

Last Year Blacklands had superb support with **18** competitors; Calne had **17** & Chippenham **11** entrants.

This year lets show even more support & make 2008 even better!

Competition Format

All competitors will be divided in to weight categories and will have 3-4 contests each. 10 points will be awarded for a win, regardless of score, 5 points for a score draw and 1 point for a no score draw. A bonus point will be awarded for each contest won by an Ippon score.

The two competitors with the most points will meet in the final and compete for the gold medal. The third and forth highest scores will compete for third place. The total points awarded during each contest i.e. Koka, Yoko, Waza-Ari and Ippon will be used to determine positions in the event where points are tied.

Points are awarded to the club of the medallist is as follows:

- 10** points – Gold Medal
- 8** Points – Silver Medal
- 6** Points – Bronze (Third Place)
- 4** Points – Bronze (Fourth Place)

The club with the most points will be awarded the **Shodan Trophy**.

Weight Categories

Like most competitions of this format the weight categories will be finalised on the day of the competition. We aim to have at least six competitors per category. Referees will do their best to match competitor size and ability as best they can and male and female juniors will compete together.

Tiny, tiny tots	- Under 26kg	Little terrors	- 38 – 48
Tiny Tots	- 26 –32	Big terrors	- 48 – 60
Tots	- 32 –38	Childen of Satan	- 60+

Men's weight Categories have been joined to form the following:

Under 80 kg	- Lightweight /Middleweight
+80 kg	- Middleweight / Heavyweights

Most of our Woman Seniors fall into the lightweight category of **48 – 57kg**. Anyone above this weight is more than welcome to enter and in which case the Woman's becomes an Open championship.

Competitors are welcome to turn up on the day but please be aware that places are limited. It is best to Book early to ensure your place and avoid disappointment and a wasted journey. Speak to your coach should you require more information or have difficulties with the fee or transport. We will do our best to be of assistance.

Important Stuff!!!

- You need to be a current member of eudo in order to compete. This is important because personal accident Insurance is part of your membership package. Competitors from non eudo clubs are more than welcome to compete but it is your responsibility to ensure you have valid insurance cover from your Judo association and Shodan Judo will not be held liable for any failure to do so.
- Number of contests depends on the size of each category and time permitting. The aim is a minimum of three.
- All competitors under the age of 16 remain the responsibility of parents or guardians when not on the Judo Mat. Shodan Judo only has the resources to take responsibility for competitors on the mat and juniors should not be left unattended particularly during Lunch and whilst the seniors are competing.
- Shodan Judo will in no way accept any responsibility for any Loss, Damage or Injuries as a result of attending this competition.

Key Rules

No Arm Locks or Strangles for competitors under the age of 16 unless told otherwise.
25 Seconds for an Ippon score on hold-downs.
4-minute contests for seniors and 2 Minute contests for juniors.
Two Shidos / Penalties equals an Ippon win to your opponent and no score for you.
Other than Shido rule, full IJF regulations will be imposed with referee's decision being final.
